Inventory of Conifer Species in 2008: 3.9 billion board feet

Volume Harvested from 2008 through 2023: 807.7 million board feet

Inventory of Conifer Species through 2023: 4.998 billion board feet

Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 2008 through 2023: 1.8 billion board feet

Seedlings planted since 2008: 1,812,270

Soil Removed or Stabilized since 2008: 527,144 cubic yards (or 52,714

truckloads)

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree-by-tree basis, in a contained manner over 15 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre: 26.3 ounces per acre treated

(3.2 measuring cups per acre)

Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date: 3,322 gallons over 15 years

Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 2008: 16,150 acres over 15 years

Target conifer trees per acre after treatment: 275
