Inventory of Conifer Species in 1998:	2.1 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 1998 through 2024:	920.4 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species end of 2024:	4.55 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 1998 thru 2024:	3.37 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 1998:	12,657,790
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 1998:	1,505,789 cubic yards, larger than the Empire State Building (or 150,579 truckloads)
Roads rocked, abandoned or improved since 1998:	132.7 miles
Road crossing upgrades:	Over 4,111 crossings
Fish Barriers Removed (see photos below):	38 fish barriers, opening over 28.1 miles of streams

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree-by-tree basis, in a contained manner over 26 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	23 ounces per acre treated (2.8 measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	16,029 gallons over 26 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 1998:	89,502 acres frill method over 26 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	225
