Inventory of Conifer Species in 1998:	2.1 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 1998 - 2025:	958.5 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species end of 2025:	4.6 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 1998 - 2025:	3.4 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 1998:	13,003,314
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 1998:	1,511,362 cubic yards, larger than the Empire State Building (or 151,136 truckloads)
Roads rocked, abandoned or improved since 1998:	135 miles
Road crossing upgrades:	Over 4,204 crossings
Fish Barriers Removed (see photos below):	38 fish barriers, opening over 28.1 miles of streams

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree-by-tree basis, in a contained manner over 27 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	23 ounces per acre treated (2.8 measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	16,205 gallons over 27 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 1998:	90,326 acres frill method over 27 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	225
